Special for the mutation is that their original color is retained under the wings. The double factors is the exhibition bird with an outstanding color on the face . You can pair them to Greys, Ino's, Violets and even Slates. In the past I have paired them with Slates and Ino's. Paired with Albino you obtain a nearly yellow bird. In Slate you have a lovely contrast between the yellow face and the slate body color.
